

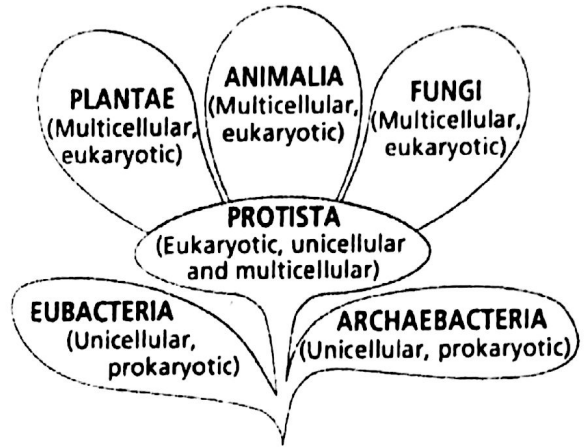
## Characteristics of Living Things Homework
